The following sentences describe moments from the *Sweeney Todd* story, but they are in the wrong order. Your task is to rearrange them in the proper order in which they occur in the story.

When you have decided on the correct order, copy the sentences in your book/folder as neatly as you can.

Sentences (in the wrong order)

- A Judge Turpin throws Lucy out onto the streets but keeps the baby girl.
- B Lucy becomes pregnant. Benjamin Barker is the father.
- C Benjamin Barker works as a barber on Fleet Street.
- D Benjamin Barker marries Lucy.
- E Benjamin Barker escapes from Australia and renames himself Sweeney Todd.
- F Sweeney Todd arrives back in London 15 years after leaving there for a crime he did not commit.
- G Judge Turpin lures Lucy to his house where he keeps her trapped.
- H Judge Turpin quietly starts to threaten Benjamin Barker and to take more of an interest in Lucy.
- I Lucy is admired by Judge Turpin.
- J Judge Turpin sends one of his servants to Barker's barber shop and frames him by placing money in Barker's coat and then accusing him of being a thief.
- K Barker is brought before the Judge and sent to Australia for a life sentence.
- L The baby is born – it's a girl.
- M Todd sets off to Fleet Street to find out what became of his wife, his child and his old barber shop.
